Young children notice differences and experiment with teasing, bullying and exclusion. By the time they are six months old they notice differences in race and gender, by age 2 they may have developed racial preferences and by age 4 they are already experimenting with teasing and leaving kids out. As caring providers, we can make a difference by talking to kids about what they observe and nurturing their ability to empathize with each other and stand up for themselves and others.
